Who should make the nominations?

Clients, professional practices, contractors, developers or individuals involved in the project should make nominations.

(Please note, you cannot self-nominate).



All Nominations MUST be accompanied by the following:

- A passport style head and shoulders photograph of yourself in a high resolution jpeg format (no hard hats please)
- A project synopsis written by the nominated Clerk of Works in word.doc format
- Photographic record of the project including the completed works maximum 10 photos please
- £50 entry fee (you can pay via cheque made out to ICWCI, or contact ICWCI HQ for card payments)

Failure to provide any of the above with your nomination may result in disqualification from the awards programme.

Photographs and synopsis must be sent in an electronic format - either on a CD, memory stick or sent as an attachment to an email.

Judging will take place in early 2022, culminating in a Gala Awards evening to be hosted over the ICWCI Conference weekend 2022.

The Judges' decision is final, and no correspondence concerning their decisions will be entertained.

Participation infers automatic agreement to the use of a company or individual's name in promotional and PR work related to the Awards Programme by the ICWCI.

Submissions and their attachments are non-returnable unless specific arrangements are made with the organisers.
